

Proclamation

- WHEREAS: A CRIME WAS COMMITTED EVERY FOUR MINUTES IN MINNESOTA DURING THE FIRST NINE MONTHS OF 1981; AND
- WHEREAS: THE PREVENTION OF CRIME SHOULD BE THE OBJECTIVE OF ALL MINNESOTANS:

 CONCERNED WITH SAFER HOMES, STREETS AND NEIGHBORHOODS; AND
- WHEREAS: Effective crime prevention requires each Minnesotan to take the initiative in discouraging persons from committing unlawful acts; and
- WHEREAS: EACH MINNESOTAN CAN COOPERATE WITH LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICIALS TO RESIST CRIME BY LOCKING DOORS AND WINDOWS AND PROMOTING SAFE NEIGHBOR-HOODS: AND
- WHEREAS: Crime prevention strategies like Operation Identification, a free burglary reduction program available from local police and sheriff departments, and Neighborhood Watch do work to curtail crime;
- NOW. THEREFORE. I. ALBERT H. QUIE. GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA. DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF FEBRUARY 7 THROUGH FEBRUARY 13. 1982 TO BE

CRIME PREVENTION WEEK

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER I URGE CITIZENS TO PRACTICE CRIME PREVENTION TECHNIQUES AVAILABLE FROM LOCAL POLICE AND SHERIFF DEPARTMENTS DESIGNED TO HELP PEOPLE AVOID BECOMING VICTIMS OF BURGLARY, ASSAULT, THEFT AND OTHER CRIMES.
