



Proclamation

WHEREAS: THE STRENGTH OF MINNESOTA IS AGRICULTURE, INCLUDING THE PRODUCTION, PROCESSING, MARKETING, AND DISTRIBUTION OF FOOD; AND

WHEREAS: PROGRAMS OF VOCATIONAL AGRICULTURAL EDUCATION IN 278 PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOLS IN MINNESOTA CONTRIBUTE TO THE EDUCATION, TRAINING AND MOTIVATION OF FUTURE LEADERS IN AGRICULTURE AND AGRIBUSINESS; AND

WHEREAS: THE FUTURE FARMERS OF AMERICA, AN INTEGRAL PART OF THE AGRICULTURAL EDUCATION PROCESS, CHALLENGES MEMBERS TO LEARN, TO DO, TO EARN, AND TO SERVE; AND

WHEREAS: 1982 IS THE 52ND ANNIVERSARY OF THE MINNESOTA ASSOCIATION OF THE FUTURE FARMERS OF AMERICA, AN ORGANIZATION OF 15,000 ACTIVE MEMBERS; AND

WHEREAS: "VOCATIONAL AGRICULTURE - GROWING FOR AMERICA" IS THE 1982 THEME OF THE FUTURE FARMERS OF AMERICA; AND

WHEREAS: JAMES LOVEN, CANNON FALLS AND BYRAN SOMMER, FAIRFAX, WERE NATIONAL PROFICIENCY WINNERS IN AGRICULTURAL ELECTRIFICATION AND CROP PRODUCTION AND THE LAKEFIELD AND LEROY-OSTRANDER CHAPTERS WON NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS IN THE LIVESTOCK AND AGRICULTURAL MECHANICS CONTESTS;
