



Proclamation

HEREAS: THE WORD PROCESSING ASSOCIATION OF MINNESOTA, INC., IS SPONSORING THEIR 9TH ANNUAL SYMPOSIUM AND EXHIBITION OF WORD PROCESSING EQUIPMENT AT THE RADISSON ST. PAUL ON MAY 19 AND 20, 1982; AND

HEREAS: WORD PROCESSING, WHICH HAS GAINED NATIONAL ACCEPTANCE, EVOLVED AS A MEANS OF RESPONDING TO THE CONCERNS OF GOVERNMENT AND INDUSTRY OVER THE INCREASING COST OF CLERICAL PERSONNEL, OFFICE EQUIPMENT AND SPACE, PLUS THE SKY-ROCKETING VOLUME OF PAPERWORK; AND
