WHEREAS: DENTAL DISEASE IS THE MOST PREVALENT DISEASE OF MANKIND, SUFFERED BY NEARLY ALL AMERICANS; AND

WHEREAS: DENTAL DISEASE IS PREVENTABLE THROUGH EDUCATION AND INFORMATION; AND

WHEREAS: THIS EDUCATION AND INFORMATION CAN BE RECEIVED THROUGH THE NEW TEL-A-DENT PHONE LINE WHICH SERVES THE PUBLIC BY PROMOTING DENTAL AWARENESS AND THE INFORMATION NECESSARY TO PREVENT DENTAL DISEASE; AND

WHEREAS: TEL-A-DENT IS A TAPE INFORMATION LIBRARY, AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC BY DIALING THEIR TELEPHONE, WHICH ENABLES CITIZENS OF MINNESOTA TO ACQUIRE CURRENT AND ACCURATE INFORMATION IN ORDER TO MAKE SOUND DECISIONS REGARDING DENTAL CARE;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF FEBRUARY 7 THROUGH FEBRUARY 13, 1982 TO BE

TEL - A - DENT INFORMATION WEEK

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER, I URGE CITIZENS TO USE AND RECOGNIZE THE VALUE OF TEL-A-DENT.
