WHEREAS: WE ARE LIVING IN AN ERA WHEN STABILITY HAS BECOME A NECESSARY COMPONENT OF OUR SURVIVAL; AND

HEREAS: Sound Judgment, self-control, and strength of character are components of STABILITY, whether in individual or nation; and

WHEREAS: Abstinence from alcohol, other narcotics, and tobacco, will greatly enhance the preservation of these components, resulting in saved lives, physically, mentally, and socially;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF APRIL 27 THROUGH MAY 1, 1982 TO BE

YOUTH TEMPERANCE EDUCATION WEEK

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE, AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER, I JRGE CITIZENS TO OBSERVE THIS WEEK WITH APPROPRIATE ACTIVITIES.
