Councilman Huntley introduced the following resolution and moved for its adoption:

RESOLUTION NO. 81-60

An Ordinance Extending the Corporate Limits
Of The City of Grand Rapids, Minnesota
To Include Certain Unplatted Lands Abutting Upon the City Limits

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated May 12, 1981, requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the Council, and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition is approximately 10 acres, and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the town board, the county board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed, and

WHEREAS, a hearing was duly held by the governing body of the City of Grand Rapids, Minnesota on the proposed annexation, and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the City limits at the North and West boundary thereof; and

WHEREAS, Rev. Bowe, who is the owner of this property, has verbally agreed during the open hearing, that curb and gutter shall be installed in 1982 and fully agrees and acquiesces in 100% assessment of the improvement; and

WHEREAS, Rev. Bowe has verbally agreed and fully understands that the unpaid balance of a 1975 Bituminous Surfacing and Storm Sewer assessment against this property will be assessed in 1982.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the City Council of the City of Grand Rapids, hereby ordains:

Section 1. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the City of Grand Rapids are hereby extended to include the South 660 feet of the East 1/2 of the SE 1/4 of SE 1/4, Section 18, Township 55 N, Range 25 W.

Section 2. Filing. The City Clerk is directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Secretary of State, the County Auditor of the county in which the property is located, and the Minnesota Municipal Commission.

Section 3. Effective Date of Annexation. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of certified copies as directed in Section 2.


Passed and adopted this 10th day of November, 1981.
