ORDINANCE NO. 136

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY
OF LAKEFIELD TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED
TERRITORY BORDERED BY LAND WITHIN THE
CITY LIMITS AND ADJUTING THEREON

WHEREAS, certain territory described below is not presently included within the corporate limits of any incorporated city, or borough; and

WHEREAS, 60% or more of the perimeter of this territory is bordered by lands already included within the corporate limits of the City and is deemed to be urban in character;

The City Council of Lakefield, Minnesota ordains:

Section 1. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the City of Lakefield, Minnesota, are hereby extended to include the unplatted territory described as follows, 60% or more of the perimeter of which territory is bordered by territory already included within the City limits:

Commencing at a point 40 rods North of the Southwest Corner of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section No. 33, Township 103 North, Range 36 West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, which point is the point of commencement; thence continuing North 107.7 feet; thence East 150 feet; thence North 100 feet; thence East 50 feet; thence South 207.8 feet; thence West 200 feet to the point of beginning, Jackson County, Minnesota,

Section 2. Filing. The City Clerk is directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Secretary of State, the Jackson County, Minnesota, Auditor, the Town Clerk of the Heron Lake Township and the Minnesota Municipal Board.

Section 3. Effective Date of Annexation. This ordinance takes effect upon passage and publication and the filing of certified copies as directed in Section 2.
