



Proclamation

WHEREAS: HOME ECONOMICS AND RELATED TRAINING, THE STATE ORGANIZATION FOR HOME ECONOMICS RELATED OCCUPATIONS STUDENTS, HELPS YOUTH ASSUME THEIR ROLES IN SOCIETY THROUGH HOME ECONOMICS EDUCATION IN AREAS OF PERSONAL GROWTH, FAMILY LIFE, VOCATIONAL PREPARATION AND COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT; AND

WHEREAS: THE ORGANIZATION EXTENDS CLASSROOM LEARNING THROUGH CHAPTER PROJECTS THAT DEVELOP LEADERSHIP AND INITIATIVE AND HELP YOUNG MEN AND WOMEN LEARN HOW TO PLAN, MAKE DECISIONS AND CARRY OUT AND EVALUATE PROGRAMS OF ACTION AS THEY WORK WITH OTHER YOUTH AND ADULTS IN THEIR SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY; AND

WHEREAS: HOME ECONOMICS AND RELATED TRAINING, A VOCATIONAL EDUCATION STUDENT ORGANIZATION OFFERS MEMBERS AN OPPORTUNITY TO WORK TOGETHER FOR COMMON PURPOSES FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF THEMSELVES, THEIR FAMILIES AND THEIR COMMUNITIES; AND

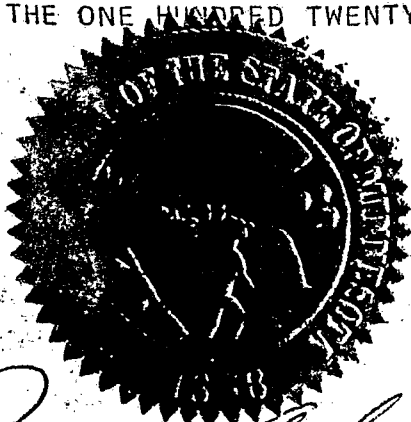

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS TWENTIETH DAY OF JANUARY, IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-TWO, AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THIRD.
