



Proclamation

WHEREAS: MINNESOTANS ARE PROUD OF THE HIGH QUALITY OF THE ENVIRONMENT OF OF OUR STATE; AND

WHEREAS: IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF EACH CITIZEN TO WORK TO MAINTAIN MINNESOTA'S BEAUTIFUL NATURAL RESOURCES SO THAT OUR CHILDREN AND OUR CHILDREN'S CHILDREN CAN ENJOY THE RICH EMOTIONAL AND SPIRITUAL BENEFITS OF NATURE; AND

WHEREAS: OUR PRESENT WASTE DISPOSAL METHODS OF LITTER AND LANDFILLING POSE AN ENVIRONMENTAL AND ECONOMIC THREAT TO OUR QUALITY OF LIFE; AND

WHEREAS: IN RECOGNITION OF THE NEED TO MAINTAIN AND ENHANCE MINNESOTA'S QUALITY ENVIRONMENT, A MONTH HAS BEEN SET ASIDE TO "KEEP MINNESOTA BEAUTIFUL" AND

WHEREAS: DURING THIS MONTH, MINNESOTANS ARE INVITED TO SHOW THEIR CONCERN FOR OUR ENVIRONMENT THROUGH POSITIVE ACTION IN A CONCENTRATED EFFORT TO KEEP OUR ENVIRONMENT CLEAN, HEALTHFUL, AND BEAUTIFUL;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM APRIL 24 THROUGH MAY 22, 1982 TO BE

"KEEP MINNESOTA BEAUTIFUL MONTH"

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER, I URGE CITIZENS, BUSINESSES, CIVIC GROUPS, GOVERNMENT AGENCIES, AND OTHER ORGANIZATIONS TO WORK TOGETHER TO PRESERVE AND ENHANCE THE SPECIAL BEAUTY OF MINNESOTA.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS TWENTY-NINTH DAY OF JANUARY IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-TWO, AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THIRD.
