WHEREAS: MORE MINNESOTANS FROM ALL WALKS OF LIFE EACH YEAR ARE FINDING THE LIFESTYLE OF MANUFACTURED HOUSING TO BE ENJOYABLE AND PRACTICAL; AND

WHEREAS: THE MANUFACTURED HOUSING INDUSTRY IS AN IMPORTANT SEGMENT OF MINNESOTA'S ECONOMY PROVIDING A NEEDED PRODUCT AND JOBS FOR OUR CITIZENS:
