WHEREAS: THE MINNESOTA STATE MEDICAL ASSISTANTS PROVIDES PROFESSIONAL EDUCATION FOR ITS MEMBERS, ENABLING THEM TO BETTER FULFILL THEIR WORK RESPONSIBILITIES AND ENCOURAGING THEM TO SEEK GREATER KNOWLEDGE OF MEDICAL SCIENCE; AND

WHEREAS: THE MINNESOTA STATE MEDICAL ASSISTANTS ARE MEETING FOR THEIR 1982 STATE CONVENTION IN ST. PAUL, MINNESOTA, APRIL 16 AND 17, 1982;
