WHEREAS: THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA AND THE NORWEGIAN PEOPLE SHARES A MULTITUDE OF CULTURAL, SOCIAL AND HISTORICAL TRADITIONS; AND

WHEREAS: As representatives of the Government and the people of Norway, the Norwegian Home Guard's contingent now in Minnesota for training with this State's National Guard symbolizes the common bonds and traditions. That continue to link us together; and

WHEREAS: A SIMILAR CONTINGENT OF MINNESOTA GUARD MEMBERS IS NOW TRAINING AT CAMP TORPO. NORWAY. IN THIS NINTH YEAR OF EXCHANGES BETWEEN THE GUARD FORCES OF OUR RESPECTIVE GOVERNMENTS; AND
