



Proclamation

WHEREAS: MINNESOTANS RECOGNIZE THAT A HEALTHY ECONOMY AND A QUALITY ENVIRONMENT GO HAND IN HAND; AND

WHEREAS: THE CHALLENGES OF THE 1980'S REQUIRE MORE EFFECTIVE, EFFICIENT MANAGEMENT OF OUR NATIONAL AND HUMAN RESOURCES; AND

WHEREAS: THE RECYCLING OF MATERIALS AND RECOVERY OF ENERGY ARE MOST EFFECTIVE ACTIONS FOR MANAGING OUR RESOURCES; AND

WHEREAS: RECYCLING CUTS ENVIRONMENTAL COSTS, BRINGS DIRECT REVENUES INTO OUR STATE, AND PROVIDES RAW MATERIALS FOR NEW AND EXISTING INDUSTRY; AND

WHEREAS: RECYCLING EDUCATION AND AWARENESS ARE AN ESSENTIAL FACTOR IN ENCOURAGING RECYCLING; AND

WHEREAS: STUDENTS, TEACHERS, AND SCHOOLS ARE AN INTEGRAL FACTOR IN PROMOTING RECYCLING AWARENESS IN OUR STATE'S COMMUNITIES;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM APRIL 18 THROUGH APRIL 24, 1982 TO BE

RECYCLING IN OUR SCHOOLS WEEK

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER, I URGE CITIZENS, BUSINESSES, CIVIC GROUPS, GOVERNMENT ORGANIZATIONS AND OTHER ORGANIZATIONS TO WORK TOGETHER TO ENCOURAGE RECYCLING EDUCATION AND AWARENESS IN OUR SCHOOLS AND COMMUNITIES.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS TWENTY-NINTH DAY OF JANUARY IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-TWO, AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THIRD.
