



Proclamation

HEREAS: THE BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA IS AN IMPORTANT YOUTH MOVEMENT WHICH CELEBRATED ITS SEVENTIETH ANNIVERSARY ON FEBRUARY 8, 1982; AND

HEREAS: THE VALUES INHERENT IN THE SCOUTING PROGRAM, SUCH AS HONESTY, SELF-RELIANCE AND RESPECT, ARE THOSE VALUES WHICH NEED CHARACTERIZE OUR TOTAL CITIZENRY AS WE FACE THE PROBLEMS OF THIS DAY; AND

HEREAS: SCOUTING'S ROLE IN THE CONSERVATION OF ENERGY AND OTHER NATURE RESOURCES IS RECOGNIZED AS AN IMPORTANT SERVICE TO OUR NATION; AND

HEREAS: THE ACHIEVEMENTS OF SCOUTING ARE THE RESULT OF A PARTNERSHIP BETWEEN THE SCOUTING MOVEMENT AND THE RESPONSIBLE FORCES FOR ACTION IN THIS NATION, WITH THE SCHOOLS, CHURCHES, CIVIC AND SERVICE CLUBS, FRATERNAL BODIES AND OTHER COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS PROVIDING THE IMMEDIATE OPPORTUNITIES FOR YOUNG PEOPLE TO ASSOCIATE WITH THE PROGRAMS OF THIS MOVEMENT; AND

HEREAS: THE DELIVERY OF THIS PROGRAM WHICH RESULTS IN CHARACTER DEVELOPMENT, CITIZENSHIP TRAINING AND TRAINING IN PHYSICAL AND MENTAL FITNESS IS DEPENDENT UPON THE SPLENDID VOLUNTEERS WHO SERVE AS CUBMASTER, SCOUT-MASTERS, EXPLORER ADVISORS, DEN MOTHERS AND OTHER LEADERSHIP POSITIONS;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF FEBRUARY 7 THROUGH 14, 1982 TO BE

SCOUTING ANNIVERSARY WEEK

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER, I URGE CITIZENS TO EXPRESS APPRECIATION TO SCOUTING AND ITS LEADERS FOR PROVIDING AN IMPORTANT SERVICE TO THE YOUTH OF OUR STATE.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS TENTH DAY OF FEBRUARY IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-TWO, AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THIRD.
