WHEREAS: COLLEGE HOCKEY PLAYS AN IMPORTANT ROLE IN THE LIFE AND VITALITY OF MINNESOTA, REQUIRING TREMENDOUS SKILL AND AGILITY, AND PROVIDING SPIRITED COMPETITION FOR SPECTATORS AND PARTICIPANTS ALIKE; AND

WHEREAS: MINNESOTA WILL BE A CENTER OF COLLEGE HOCKEY ACTIVITY IN MARCH, 1982, WHEN SEVERAL MAJOR COLLEGE HOCKEY EVENTS WILL TAKE PLACE IN OUR STATE; AND
