



Proclamation

WHEREAS: GREAT STRIDES ARE BEING MADE IN THE DIAGNOSIS AND TREATMENT OF MENTAL ILLNESS, BOTH AS AN INDIVIDUAL AND SOCIETAL PROBLEM; AND

WHEREAS: THE SCIENCE AND PRACTICE OF PSYCHOLOGY HAS CONTRIBUTED TO THE ADVANCEMENT OF SCIENTIFIC KNOWLEDGE AND TREATMENT OF MENTAL ILLNESS; AND

WHEREAS: THE IMPORTANT WORK THAT THE PSYCHOLOGISTS DO IN OUR STATE TO HELP RESTORE PEOPLE TO MENTAL HEALTH AND TO HELP THEM WORK OUT THEIR FAMILY AND VOCATIONAL PROBLEMS IS A VERY SIGNIFICANT PART OF THE SOCIAL ESTABLISHMENT; AND

WHEREAS: RESEARCH BY MINNESOTA PSYCHOLOGISTS HAS PRODUCED IMPORTANT RESULTS THAT HAVE HELPED PEOPLE TO BE MORE PRODUCTIVE IN SCHOOL AND AT WORK AND TO LIVE HEALTHIER LIVES;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF APRIL 28 THROUGH MAY 6, 1982 TO BE

PSYCHOLOGY WEEK

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME, FURTHER, I URGE CITIZENS TO INCREASE THEIR UNDERSTANDING OF THE SCIENCE AND PRACTICE OF PSYCHOLOGY AND OF HOW IT CAN BEST BE USED TO HELP THE PEOPLE OF MINNESOTA.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS SEVENTEENTH DAY OF FEBRUARY IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-TWO, AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THIRD.
