

ORDINANCE NO. 410

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF NORTHFIELD, RICE COUNTY, MINNESOTA TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED, UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA, ABUTTING UPON THE CITY LIMITS.

WHEREAS, a petition requesting the annexation of the lands hereinafter described, was duly presented to the City Council of the City of Northfield, on the 24th day of March, 1981; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition is approximately 4.55 acres of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city or village; and

WHEREAS, the petition has been signed by all of the owners of the property affected, namely the City of Northfield, Paul L. Hanson and Gordon M. Mickelsen; and

WHEREAS, both the Town Board of Northfield Township and the City Council of the City of Northfield have adopted resolutions consenting to the annexation of the lands hereinafter described by the City of Northfield to be included within its corporate limits, neither governing body having received any written objections to the annexation; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abutts upon the City limits at the southerly boundary thereof; Now therefore,

The City Council of the City of Northfield, Minnesota does ordain;

Section 1. The City Council hereby determines (1) That the annexation will be in the best interest of the City and of the territory affected; (2) That the territory described abutts upon the City limits and is about to become urban in character; and (3) That none of the territory is now included within the limits of any city or village in the State of Minnesota.

Section 2. The corporate limits of the City of Northfield are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the City limits of the City of Northfield as effectively as if it had originally been a part thereof;

All that part of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 7, Township 111 North, Range 19 West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, Rice County, Minnesota, which lies Northerly of a line drawn parallel to and 150' Southerly from the Northerly boundary line of said Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section 7.

Section 3. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, the Town Clerk of Northfield Township, and the County Auditor, and the County Recorder of Rice County, Minnesota.

Section 4. This Ordinance takes effect upon its passage and 30 days after its publication, and the filing of the

certified copies as directed in Section 3.
