WHEREAS: THE AMERICAN ASSOCIATION OF UNIVERSITY WOMEN IS THE LARGEST (195,000 members and 900 colleges and universities) and the oldest national organization for the advancement of women, education and lifelong learning; and

WHEREAS: Members of the AAUW have been able to continue their intellectual growth, to further the advancement of women and to discharge their special responsibilities to society for 100 years; and

WHEREAS: AAUW IS CURRENTLY ENGAGED IN AN ALL-OUT ACTION CAMPAIGN FOR WOMEN'S EQUITY CALLED ACTION FOR EQUITY, WHICH IS AN EDUCATIONAL EFFORT TO INCREASE AWARENESS OF THE ISSUES INVOLVED IN ACHIEVING EQUITY FOR WOMEN AND A POLITICAL EFFORT TO WIN RATIFICATION OF THE EQUAL RIGHTS AMENDMENT;
