



Proclamation

WHEREAS: THE STATE OF MINNESOTA IS SUPPORTIVE AND COMMITTED TO PROVIDE FOR THE FULL PARTICIPATION OF ALL SOCIALLY AND ECONOMICALLY DISADVANTAGED ECONOMIC ENTERPRISES IN THE STATE'S PROCUREMENT OF GOODS, SERVICES AND CONSTRUCTION; AND

WHEREAS: THE STATE OF MINNESOTA PLEDGES TO ENCOURAGE AND PARTICIPATE IN THE FUTURE DEVELOPMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES OF MINNESOTA'S SOCIALLY AND ECONOMICALLY DISADVANTAGED BUSINESS OWNERS; AND

WHEREAS: A WIDE RANGE OF SOCIALLY AND ECONOMICALLY DISADVANTAGED BUSINESS ENTERPRISES ARE AVAILABLE TO PROVIDE MANY VALUABLE GOODS AND SERVICES TO BOTH THE PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SECTORS;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM MARCH 27, 1982 TO BE

MINNESOTA SET-ASIDE PROCUREMENT DAY

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER, I URGE CITIZENS TO OBSERVE THE DAY WITH INCREASED AWARENESS OF COOPERATIVE EFFORTS TOWARD SOCIALLY AND ECONOMICALLY DISADVANTAGED BUSINESS ENTERPRISES IN MINNESOTA.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS TWENTY-SIXTH DAY OF FEBRUARY IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-TWO, AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THIRD.
