



## Proclamation

WHEREAS: WARM WEATHER BRINGS OUT BICYCLISTS OF ALL AGES, AND ALSO BRINGS THE RISK OF DANGEROUS BICYCLE ACCIDENTS; AND

WHEREAS: HALF OF ALL BICYCLE/AUTO ACCIDENTS INVOLVE CHILDREN BETWEEN FIVE AND FIFTEEN YEARS OF AGE; AND

WHEREAS: THREE OUT OF FOUR BICYCLE/AUTO ACCIDENTS ARE THE FAULT OF THE CYCLIST; AND

WHEREAS: MINNESOTA IS A NATIONAL LEADER IN PROGRAMS THAT ENHANCE THE SAFETY OF BICYCLISTS AND PROMOTE COURTEOUS, RATIONAL RIDER PRACTICES;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF MAY 2 THROUGH MAY 8, 1982 TO BE

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS TWENTY-FOURTH DAY OF MARCH IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-TWO AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THIRD.
