WHEREAS: Warm weather brings out bicyclists of all ages, and also brings the risk of dangerous bicycle accidents; and

WHEREAS: Half of all bicycle/auto accidents involve children between five and fifteen years of age; and

WHEREAS: Three out of four bicycle/auto accidents are the fault of the cyclist; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota is a national leader in programs that enhance the safety of bicyclists and promote courteous, rational rider practices;

NOW. THEREFORE. I. ALBERT H. QUIE. GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA. DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF MAY 2 THROUGH MAY 8. 1982 TO BE

BICYCLE SAFETY WEEK

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER, I URGE CITIZENS TO TAKE DECISIVE ACTIONS WHICH WILL ASSURE GREATER SAFETY FOR BICYCLISTS IN OUR STATE.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF. WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS TWENTY-FOURTH DAY OF MARCH IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-TWO AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THIRD.
