



Proclamation

WHEREAS: BEHIND THE INTENT OF THE DECADE OLD CIVIL RIGHTS ACT OF 1968 IS AN UNDERLYING SPIRIT WHICH SHOULD APPEAL TO THE HUMANITY IN EVERY AMERICAN; AND

WHEREAS: SIMPLY STATED, IT IS RIGHT FOR EACH OF US TO SEE THAT EVERY PERSON IS ALLOWED TO LIVE WHERE HE OR SHE CHOOSES, FOR AS LONG AS THAT PERSON CAN AFFORD TO DO SO; AND

WHEREAS: THIS IS NOT JUST A TENET OF DEMOCRACY, AND IS MORE THAN A PRINCIPLE CODIFIED IN LAW, IT IS HUMAN CANNON AS WELL; AND

WHEREAS: THE MINNESOTA ASSOCIATION OF REALTORS JOIN THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD) IN THE ANNUAL OBSERVANCE OF FAIR HOUSING MONTH, AIMED AT INCREASING THE AWARENESS OF THE RIGHT TO FAIR HOUSING GUARANTEED BY TITLE VIII OF THE CIVIL RIGHTS ACT OF 1968;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE MONTH OF APRIL, 1982 TO BE

FAIR HOUSING MONTH

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER, I ENCOURAGE MINNESOTANS TO JOIN WITH THE MINNESOTA ASSOCIATION OF REALTORS AND THE DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT IN THIS OBSERVANCE, NOT ONLY DURING THE MONTH OF APRIL, BUT THROUGHOUT THE ENTIRE YEAR.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS TWENTY-FOURTH DAY OF MARCH IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-TWO AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THIRD.
