

Proclamation

WHEREAS: MINNESOTA HAS LONG ENJOYED A NATIONAL REPUTATION AS A STATE THAT OFFERS THE "GOOD LIFE" WHERE ITS FRIENDLY CITIZENS LOVE MUSIC; AND

WHEREAS: Minnesota has many outstanding choral groups whose members sing as professionals or simply for the Joy best expressed in heartfelt song; and

WHEREAS: DIRECTORS OF THE ASSOCIATED MALE CHORUSES OF AMERICA, REPRESENTING ASSOCIATIONS FROM THROUGHOUT THE UNITED STATES AND CANADA, WILL CONVENE IN NEW ULM ON SATURDAY, APRIL 24, FOR A DAY-LONG BUSINESS MEETING; AND

WHEREAS: In the evening, the Concord Singers of New Ulm will sponsor the "Golden Anniversary Big Sing" which will commemorate their 50 years of service in song to the community of New Ulm and in which some 600 male voices comprising sixteen male choruses from the Upper Midwest and Canada will participate;

NOW, THEREFORE, I. ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM SATURDAY, APRIL 24, 1982 TO BE
