



Proclamation

WHEREAS: THE HUBERT H. HUMPHREY CANCER RESEARCH FUND COMMITTEE OF DELANO, MINNESOTA WILL COMMEMORATE "THE 5TH ANNIVERSARY" BENEFIT DANCE FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF MINNESOTA'S HUBERT H. HUMPHREY CANCER RESEARCH FUND; AND

WHEREAS: LAST YEAR'S BENEFIT DANCE ATTRACTED A SINGLE DAY BALLROOM MINNESOTA RECORD OF 4,500 PEOPLE AND RAISED THOUSANDS OF DOLLARS FOR THIS WORTHY CAUSE; AND

WHEREAS: THIS YEAR'S DANCE, IN COOPERATION WITH KTCR AM AND FM RADIO STATION, WILL BE HELD AT THE MEDINA BALLROOM IN HAMEL, MINNESOTA FROM 12 NOON TO 11:00 P.M.; AND

WHEREAS: THIS DANCE WILL BE ATTENDED BY A BROAD RANGE OF MINNESOTA CITIZENS, INCLUDING JOHNNY HOLM BAND, ROGER RAINY AND THE BREAKERS ALONG WITH OZZIE'S SHOW BAND, PERSONALITIES FROM LOCAL TELEVISION AND RADIO STATIONS, PROFESSIONAL SPORTS AND THE CROSSROADS SCHOOL OF CHRIST DANCE AND POLKA LOVERS CLUB OF AMERICA, AND MEMBERS OF THE HUMPHREY FAMILY; AND

WHEREAS: NANCY NELSON AND WARREN MARTIN OF WTCN-TV WILL BE THIS YEAR'S STATE HONORARY CHAIRPERSONS FOR THE HUBERT H. HUMPHREY MEMORIAL DAY OBSERVANCE;

WHEREAS: THIS TRIBUTE REFLECTS THE GREAT REGARD WHICH THE PEOPLE OF MINNESOTA HOLD FOR THE LATE HUBERT H. HUMPHREY, AND THE DEDICATION WE ALL HAVE TO CONQUERING CANCER;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM MARCH 28, 1982 TO BE

HUBERT H. HUMPHREY MEMORIAL DAY

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER, I URGE CITIZENS TO JOIN IN THIS EFFORT TO SUPPORT CANCER RESEARCH AT THE UNIVERSITY OF MINNESOTA HOSPITALS.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS TWELFTH DAY OF MARCH IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-TWO, AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THIRD.
