

## **Proclamation**

WHEREAS: This nation is kept strong and free by the Loyal citizens who preserve OUR PRECIOUS FREEDOM HERITAGE THROUGH THEIR POSITIVE PATRIOTIC DECLARATIONS AND ACTIONS; AND

WHEREAS: ALL LOYAL CITIZENS SHOULD MAKE IT THEIR DUTY TO INSPIRE COMPLETE PATRIOTISM AMONG ALL OF OUR PEOPLES; AND

WHEREAS: WE URGENTLY NEED A VIGOROUS DISPLAY OF TRUE RED, WHITE AND BLUE AMERICANISM, THUS CONVINCING FRIENDS AND ENEMIES ALIKE THAT OUR NATION IS FIRMLY UNITED FOR SELF-PRESERVATION;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE FIRST DAY OF MAY, 1982 TO BE

IN MINNESOTA AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER, I URGE CITIZENS-TO PUBLICLY REAFFIRM THEIR STRONG ALLEGIANCE TO OUR FLAG AND COUNTRY, THROUGH ACTIVE PARTICIPATION IN PATRIOTIC PROGRAMS BEING SPONSORED BY THE VETERANS OF FOREIGN WARS OF THE UNITED STATES, AND OTHERS ON LOYALTY DAY.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF. WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS SEVENTH DAY OF APRIL IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-TWO, AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THIRD.
