WHEREAS: THE CREDIT GRANTERS AND CREDIT REPORTING COMPANIES OF ST. PAUL AND MINNEAPOLIS. IN COOPERATION WITH CREDIT GRANTERS THROUGHOUT THE STATE OF MINNESOTA. ARE OBSERVING NATIONAL CONSUMER CREDIT EDUCATION WEEK IN THE SPIRIT OF FREE ENTERPRISE IN AMERICA; AND

WHEREAS: These consumer credit executives are also celebrating National Consumer Credit Education Week with emphasis upon the theme, "For a Good Life - Have Good Credit"; and

WHEREAS: The officials of the State of Minnesota are aware of the importance of furthering the education of the consumer in credit management so that they may realize fuller benefits from the necessary expenditure of income today and tomorrow; and

WHEREAS: It is the aim of this observance to improve the ethical climate of business in the State of Minnesota and safeguard the rights of the consumer:
