WHEREAS: PRODUCTIVITY IMPROVEMENT IS RECOGNIZED AS A PRIMARY NEED NOT ONLY IN MINNESOTA BUT OUR ENTIRE COUNTRY; AND

WHEREAS: EDUCATION IN CHANGED MANAGEMENT STYLES AND TECHNIQUES FOR LABOR AND MANAGEMENT PERSONS IS BASIC TO EFFECTING IMPROVEMENT; AND

WHEREAS: THE MINNESOTA CHAPTER, AMERICAN SOCIETY FOR PERFORMANCE IMPROVEMENT HAS FOR TWO YEARS SPONSORED PRESENTATIONS AND SEMINARS TOWARD PRODUCTIVITY EDUCATION; AND

WHEREAS: THE COMBINED ANNUAL NATIONAL CONFERENCE OF THE AMERICAN SOCIETY FOR PERFORMANCE IMPROVEMENT AND THE IMPROVEMENT INSTITUTE WILL BE AT THE RADISSON SOUTH JUNE 28 THROUGH JULY 2;
