

Proclamation

WHEREAS: CHILDREN MUST BE GIVEN THE MEANS NECESSARY TO GROW AND DEVELOP TO THEIR FULL POTENTIAL; AND

WHEREAS: CHILDREN HAVE THE RIGHT TO ADEQUATE SHELTER, EDUCATION, SANITATION, HEALTH CARE, CLEAN WATER AND NUTRITION; AND

WHEREAS: These needs are best met by meeting the needs of their families AND COMMUNITIES; AND

WHEREAS: CHILDREN MUST BE NURTURED AND PROTECTED WITHOUT CONSIDERATION OF RACE, NATIONALITY OR CREED; AND

WHEREAS: Each of us has the ability and responsibility to help create an-ENVIRONMENT IN WHICH CHILDREN CAN LIVE FULFILLED LIVES - IN OUR FAMILIES. OUR COMMUNITIES, OUR STATE, OUR COUNTRY AND OUR WORLD;

NOW, THEREFORE, I. ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF MAY 1 THROUGH MAY 7. 1982 TO BE

SAVE THE CHILDREN WEEK

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER, I URGE CITIZENS TO REFLECT ON THE SOCIETY WE ARE BUILDING FOR CHILDREN AND TO TAKE ACTION IN SOME SMALL WAY TO IMPROVE THAT SOCIETY SO THAT OUR CHILDREN MAY GROW AND FLOURISH IN THIS AND FUTURE GENERATIONS.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS TWENTY-NINTH DAY OF APRIL IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-TWO AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THIRD.
