ORDINANCE NO. 623

CITY OF BAYPORT
WASHINGTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS
OF THE CITY OF BAYPORT, WASHINGTON COUNTY,
MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN LANDS

The City Council of the City of Bayport, Washington
County, Minnesota, does ordain:

- Section 1. A Petition has been filed with the governing body of the City of Bayport, Minnesota, by a majority of the property owners of the following described real estate to have such land included within the City of Bayport, Washington County, Minnesota:
- All of Government Lot 4, Section
14, Township 29 North, Range 20
West, Washington County, Minnesota.
- Section 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description and bounded as described is approximately twenty-three (23) acres, more or less.
- Section 3. Copies of the Petition presented to the City Council of the City of Bayport have been filed with the Minnesota Municipal Board and all governmental subdivisions required by law. Further, that no objections thereto have been submitted to the Minnesota Municipal Board or the City of Bayport within ninety (90) days of the date of service of such copies with the Minnesota Municipal Board and all other governmental subdivisions required by law. That public hearing was duly held as required by law after thirty (30) days mailed notice to all property owners in the affected area.
- Section 4. That the City Council hereby determines and ordains:
- (1) That the annexation of the aforementioned lands will be in the best interests of the City of Bayport, Minnesota, and the territory affected;

(2) That the territory described herein abuts upon the City and is so conditioned as property to be subjected to City government;

(3) That the aforementioned land is now or is about to be come urban or suburban in character.

Section 5. That the City Council does ordain that the corporate limits of the City are hereby extended to include the property described in Section 1 above, and the same is hereby annexed to and included in the City of Bayport as effectually as if it had originally been part thereof.

Section 6. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Board, Baytown Township, Washington County Auditor, and Secretary of State for the State of Minnesota.

Section 7. This Ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 6.
