An ordinance annexing land into the City of Fosston

## Section 1. RECITALS.

A. WHEREAS, Lorraine A. Carlson, has filed a Petition for Annexation by the City of Fosston of the following described real property:

That part of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW\(\frac{1}{2}\)NW\(\frac{1}{2}\)) of Section Three (3), Township One Hundred Forty-seven (147), North of Range Forty (40), West of the Fifth Principal Meridian in Minnesota and described as follows:




