DELEGATION ORDER

Providing for the Assignment of Duties

I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and Minnesota Statutes, Section 4.07, hereby issue this Delegation Order.

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development, under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 as amended through the Housing and Community Development Amendments of 1981, Public Law 97-35, makes available to the several states moneys for distribution of community development grants to local governments; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 4.13 the Commissioner of the Department of Energy, Planning and Development has authority to apply for federal funds from the federal government for the purpose of enhancing local and urban affairs; and,

WHEREAS, no State agency has been otherwise designated by law to apply for, receive, and accept federal funds for these purposes; and,


WHEREAS, the Governor has authority to designate a State agency to act for him in applying for, receiving, and accepting federal funds as provided by Minnesota Statutes, Section 4.07, Subdivisions 1 through 3.

NOW, THEREFORE, I order that:


1. The Department of Energy, Planning and Development be designated as the State agency to act for me, in applying for, receiving, accepting and expending community development block grant funds for non-entitlement area governments pursuant to Public Law 97-35.

This order shall be effective immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State and shall remain in effect until superseded, amended, or repealed by proper authority.
