WHEREAS: THE CONTRIBUTIONS TO AMERICA FROM THOSE OF GERMAN ORIGIN ARE MANY, AND CAN BE SEEN IN OUR CITIES, CLASSROOMS, BUSINESSES AND GOVERNMENT; AND

WHEREAS: ON THIS 25TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE VOLKSFEST ASSOCIATION OF MINNESOTA, SPECIAL RECOGNITION IS GIVEN FOR THE CONTRIBUTIONS OF ITS MEMBERS TO THE STATE OF MINNESOTA;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM JUNE 13, 1982 TO BE
