



Proclamation

WHEREAS: THE GENERAL PUBLIC NEEDS TO BE MORE AWARE OF THE PROBLEM OF MISSING CHILDREN; AND

WHEREAS: THERE IS AN ESTIMATED 150,000 CHILDREN THAT DISAPPEAR FROM THEIR HOMES EVERY YEAR IN THIS COUNTRY; AND

WHEREAS: EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS SHOULD BE DEVELOPED TO ASSIST LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES IN THEIR SEARCH TO RECOVER MISSING CHILDREN; AND

WHEREAS: A BILL HAS BEEN INTRODUCED IN CONGRESS TO ESTABLISH A NATIONAL CLEARINGHOUSE ON MISSING CHILDREN; AND

WHEREAS: CHILD FIND, INC. OF NEW PALTZ, NEW YORK HAS BEEN ESTABLISHED TO HELP CHILDREN AND PARENTS FIND EACH OTHER;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM MAY 25, 1982 TO BE

MISSING CHILDREN DAY

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER, I URGE CITIZENS TO BE AWARE OF THIS URGENT AND TRAGIC PROBLEM.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS ELEVENTH DAY OF MAY IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-TWO AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-FOURTH.
