On May 12, 1982 the Minnesota Municipal Board received resolutions from the City of Lakeland which requested the detachment of certain property and the City of Lakeland Shores which requested the annexation of the same territory pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 414.061.

After review of the resolutions, the Minnesota Municipal Board hereby makes and files the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

## FINDINGS OF FACT

I. That a resolution supporting detachment of certain properties was received from the City of Lakeland and a resolution supporting annexation of said property was received from the City of Lakeland Shores.

2. The resolutions contained all the information required by statute including a description of the territory proposed for detachment and annexation which is as follows:

> Commencing at the intersection of the intersection of the South line of Courtland Street in the plat of Lakeland City, according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Washington County, Minnesota, with the center line of State Highway 95; thence Easterly on the South line of said Courtland Street 700 feet to a point; thence Southerly on a line parallel to the center line of said State Highway 95, 360 feet to a point; thence Westerly and parallel to the South line of said Courtland Street to the center line of said Highway 95; thence Northerly on the center line of said Highway 95 to the point of the beginning.

3. The area proposed for detachment is situated within the City of

Lakeland and abuts the municipal boundary of the City of Lakeland Shores.

## CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Minnesota Municipal Board duly acquired and now has jurisdiction of the within proceeding.

2. An order should be issued by the Minnesota Municipal Board concurrently detaching and annexing the area described herein.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the property described in Findings of Fact 2, be and the same hereby is, detached from the City of Lakeland and annexed to the City of Lakeland Shores, the same as if it had originally been made a part thereof.
