
The Minnesota Municipal Board has now processed and approved the above ordinance in accordance with Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 414, and the Rules of Procedure.

### AFFIDAVIT OF PUBLICATION

being duly sworn, deposes

that he is and during all the times herein stated has been the publisher

of the Chicago County Press newspaper published at the Chicago County Press and has full knowledge of the facts herein stated as follows:

- 1. Said newspaper is printed in the English language in newspaper form and the printed space is equivalent in printed space to at least 900 square inches.
- 2. Said newspaper is a weekly and is distributed at least once each week.
- 3. Said newspaper has 50% of its news column devoted to news of general interest to the community, which it purports to serve and does not wholly replicate any other publication, except for notices, notices, plate matter and advertisements.
- 4. Said newspaper is circulated in and near the municipality which it purports to serve, has at least 500 copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers, has an average of at least 1000 copies sold weekly, is currently paid for more than three months in arrears and has sufficient funds on hand to pay for postage.
- 5. Said newspaper purports to serve the City of Lindstrom in the County of Chisago, Minnesota, and it has its key office of issue in the City of Lindstrom in said county, established and maintained by regular business hours for the gathering of news, sale of advertisements and sale of subscriptions, and is maintained by a managing officer of said newspaper, or persons in its employ and subject to the control and direction of such regular business hours and at which said newspaper is printed.
- 6. Said newspaper files a copy of each issue immediately with the County Auditor of Chisago County, Minnesota.
- 7. Said newspaper has complied with all the foregoing conditions for publication of a newspaper as set forth in the statutes of this State mentioned below.
- 8. Said newspaper has filed with the Secretary of State of Minnesota a copy of the affidavit and a copy of the affidavit in the form prescribed by the laws of this State, and the managing officer of said newspaper has sworn to before a notary public that the newspaper is a newspaper.

He further states on oath that the printed copy of the Chicago County Press newspaper herein attached as a copy of the Chicago County Press was cut from the column of said newspaper, and was printed and published therein in the English language once each week for 1 successive weeks that it was first so published Thursday the 12 day of Feb 1982 and was thereafter printed and published on every Thursday thereafter.
