#### ORDER TO ESTABLISH FEES

EFFECTIVE: July 1, 1982

Pursuant to the authority vested in me, under Laws of Minnesota, 1982, Chapter 508, Section 3, Subdivision 3, and Chapter 635, Section 3, Subdivision 3, I hereby find the need for establishing fees and hereby order that the following fees be set for grain bank operators, grain buyers, grain terminal warehouses, and grain storage warehouses. The fees shall be effective July 1, 1982. These fees are payable to the Commissioner of Agriculture pursuant to law.

#### Grain Bank Operator, Grain Buyer, and Grain Terminal Warehouse Fees

Grain Bank License Fee	\$25.00
Grain Buyers License Fee	\$50.00
Grain Terminal Warehouse License Fee	\$75.00
Examination Fee	\$20.00 per hour per examiner


