

Proclamation

WHEREAS: THE AMERICAN REFUGEE COMMITTEE, A NONPROFIT VOLUNTARY AGENCY TO HELP INDOCHINESE REFUGEES WAS FOUNDED IN MINNESOTA IN FEBRUARY 1979; AND

WHEREAS: The American Refugee Committee has sent 250 medical volunteers, including 65 Minnesotans, to provide medical relief to refugees in Southeast Asia; and

WHEREAS: THE AMERICAN REFUGEE COMMITTEE HAS SENT THOUSANDS OF DOLLARS OF DONATED MEDICAL SUPPLIES AND PHARMACEUTICALS TO ALLEVIATE THE SUFFERING OF THE REFUGEES; AND

WHEREAS: The people of Minnesota has distinguished themselves in their support of humanitarian endeavors of the American Refugee committee;

NOW. THEREFORE, I. ALBERT H. QUIE. GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM SATURDAY, JUNE 12, 1982 TO BE

AMERICAN REFUGEE COMMITTEE DAY

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF. WE have hereunto set our hands and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed this first day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-two and of the State the one hundred twenty-fourth.
