WHEREAS: HUMANITY'S ACHIEVEMENTS IN SPACE HAVE ENRICHED THE LIVES OF MANY OF OUR WORLD'S CITIZENS: AND

WHEREAS: During the week of July 20, 1982, we celebrate the 13th Anniversary of the first landing on the moon, when Americans said, "We came in peace for all Mankind"; and

WHEREAS: THE United States Space Program has renewed and excited a sense of pioneering in the American people, giving us a feeling for the sense of adventure that motivated our ancestors' explorations; and

WHEREAS: THE United States Space Program has provided employment opportunities and Long-term economic benefits to the people of the United States through the Aerospace industry, our institutions of higher learning, and the National Aeronautics and Space Administration; and

WHEREAS: It is the stated purposes of the Minnesota Spaceweek organizers to promote national debates on present and proposed uses and directions of our journeys into space;

NOW. THEREFORE. I. ALBERT H. QUIE. GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA. DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF JULY 16 THROUGH JULY 24, 1982 TO BE

IN WITNESS WHEREOF. WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS FIRST DAY OF JUNE IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-TWO AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-FOURTH.
