ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN UNPLATTED LAND TO THE CITY OF COLD, SPRING, STEARNS COUNTY, MINNESOTA

WHEREAS, the corporate borders of the City of Cold Spring abut the certain parcels of property on more than sixty (60%) percent of said properties perimeter, said property being less than forty (40) acres, and legally described as follows:

That part of Section Fifteen (15), Township One Hundred Twenty-Three (123) North, Range Thirty (30) West, Stearns County, Minnesota, described as follows: The Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SW1/4 SW1/4) of Section Fifteen (15), Township One Hundred Twenty-Three (123) North, of Range Thirty (30) West excluding any portion thereof now located within the corporate limits of the Village of Cold Spring, Stearns County, Minnesota.

and;

WHEREAS, the City Council for the City of Cold Spring desires to annex said property to the City and include it within its corporate limits, and;

WHEREAS, it is the determination of the City Council that said property is urban or suburban in character and will best serve the interests of the City of Cold Spring if included within its corporate limits.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council for the City of Cold Spring, Minnesota, does hereby declare and ordain:

- 1. That the corporate limits of the City of Cold Spring, Stearns County, Minnesota, be and they hereby are extended to include that certain real estate herein before described and the same is hereby annexed and included in the City of Cold Spring as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.
- 2. That the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Board, the Clerk for the Town of Wakefield, the Stearns County Auditor, and the Secretary of State for the State of Minnesota.
- 3. This ordinance shall be become effective from and after its passage, publication and filing of certified copies as herein before directed.
