WHEREAS: MINNESOTA FARMWORKER YOUTH ARE A VITAL SOURCE FOR THE FUTURE LEADERS AND PRODUCTIVE CITIZENS OF MINNESOTA; AND

WHEREAS: FARMWORKER YOUTH AND THEIR FAMILIES HAVE, HISTORICALLY AUGMENTED THE AGRICULTURAL ECONOMY OF MINNESOTA; AND

WHEREAS: FARMWORKER YOUTH HAVE TAKEN DELIBERATE STEPS TOWARD ECONOMIC INDEPENDENCE THROUGH PARTICIPATION IN MINNESOTA'S EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTES; AND

WHEREAS: THE STATE OF MINNESOTA HAS PARTICIPATED IN ENABLING FARMWORKER YOUTH TO ENHANCE THEIR CAREERS THROUGH A MULTITUDE OF RESOURCES; AND

WHEREAS: THE MINNESOTA MIGRANT COUNCIL IS HAVING THE FIRST ANNUAL FARMWORKER YOUTH ASSEMBLY DURING THE DAYS OF JUNE 24 AND JUNE 25;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE DAYS OF JUNE 24 AND JUNE 25, 1982 TO BE
