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An Unserved Strip of land located in Sec. 20, Twp. 134 N., R. 29 W., 5th P.M. on the Northeast part of and adjoining Lot 7 of Sec. 29-134-29, lying just North of the Line between Sections 20 and 29 of said Township, containing approximately 0.20 acre.

You are allowed thirty (30) days from the Receipt of this Notice, within which to file in said General Land Office, any papers you may wish to submit, tending to show cause, if any there be, why the said two tracts of land should not be surveyed and disposed of as public land of the United States.
