IN THE MATTER OF THE PETITION OF THE CITY OF FLOODWOOD, MINNESOTA TO ANNEX CERTAIN ADJOINING UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY TO THE CITY.

TO THE MINNESOTA MUNICIPAL BOARD:

WHEREAS, certain territory described below is not presently included within the incorporated limits of any city; and

WHEREAS, this territory abuts upon the city limits at the Southerly boundaries thereof and is or is about to become urban or suburban in character;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF FLOODWOOD

- 1. The city council hereby determines (1) that the territory described below abuts upon the city limits and is or is about to become urban or suburban in character; and (2) that none of the territory is now included within the limits of any city.
- 2. The council hereby declares its intention to annex the following territory to the city:

Lots Four (4) through Twenty-five (25) incl. Block 2, Plat of Peterson's Lots, according to the plat thereof, in St. Louis County, Minnesota.

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF FLOODWOOD TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED PLATTED LAND (UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA) ABUTTING UPON THE CITY LIMITS.

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated 1982, request-June 1 ing annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the council on the lst day of June 1982; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by all owners; and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the town board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the city limits at the Southerly boundaries thereof;

The council of the City of Floodwood, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. The city council hereby determines (1) that the territory described herein abuts upon the city limits and is(is about to become) urban or suburban in character; and (2) that none of the term ritory is now included within the limits of any city.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the city are hereby extended to include the platted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the city as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

Lots Four (4) through Twenty-five (25) incl. Block 2, Plat of Peterson's Lots, according to the plat thereof, in St. Louis County, Minnesota.

Section 3. Filing. The city clerk is hereby directed to file certiified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Board, the Secretary of State, the Town Clerk, and the County Auditor.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3, and approval of the ordinance by the Minnesota Municipal Board.

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PETITION FOR ANNEXATION
