

## **Proclamation**

WHEREAS: Minnesota is fortunate to be the home of a great number of outstanding organizations dedicated to the performance, enhancement and encouragement of the arts; and

WHEREAS: For the third time in the Twin Cities, approximately twenty-five top arts organizations will be participating in an out-reach program at Rosedale, a metropolitan area shopping center, as a means to bring the arts to a wider cross section of people; and

WHEREAS: These twenty-five cultural groups are eager to create excitement and enthusiasm in hopes of informing citizens of activities they may not have been aware of; and

WHEREAS: This program, running from July 22nd through August 1, 1982, includes performances and demonstrations of dance, acting, mime, singing, poetry, puppetry, crafts, and film; and

WHEREAS: This "Arts Alive!" celebration is a unique joining together of Minnesota's arts community to present a program of entertainment for the purposes of informing, educating, and delighting citizens:

IN WITNESS WHEREOF. WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS FIRST DAY OF JULY IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-TWO AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-FOURTH.
