WHEREAS: October 2, 1982 will be the fifth anniversary of "Minnesota Chess Day"; and

WHEREAS: Two studies have shown that chess is an educational game as it improves numerical aptitude, spatial aptitude, administrative ability, and clerical work; and

WHEREAS: Teachers, schools, Librarians, and others with knowledge of the game of chess consider chess to be educational and beneficial to the individual and community;

NOW, THEREFORE, I. ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM OCTOBER 2, 1982 TO BE

## CHESS EDUCATION DAY

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME,

IN WITNESS WHEREOF. WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS FIRST DAY OF JULY IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-TWO AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-FOURTH.
