WHEREAS: Home sewing affects citizens of all ages and backgrounds, through elementary sewing crafts, high fashion artistic sewing, educational programs and the state sewing industry; and

WHEREAS: Home sewing will be publicly displayed via educational events, fashion shows, and other special programs, during a special week in September; and

WHEREAS: Home Sewing Guild members in Minnesota comprise the Largest sewing organization in the nation, and are actively involved in both metropolitan and rural Minnesota;

NOW, THEREFORE, I. Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of September 12 through September 18, 1982 to be

IN WITNESS WHEREOF. WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS FIRST DAY OF JULY IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-TWO AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-FOURTH.
