Clerk of Special Village Election, DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that a Special
Village Election was held and conducted at the Town Hall in the Vil-
lage of Hanterville, of the County of Dodge in the State of Minnesota,
on the 4th day of February, 1926, between the hours of Nine (9) A.M.
and Five (5) P.M. of said day, for and in behalf of said Village,
and that said Special Election was called for the purpose that said
Village may become a Separate Election and Assessment District which
proposition was duly submitted to the electors of said Village upon
ballots, duly prepared, bearing the printed words thereon, to-wit:
"Shall the Village of Hanterville, in Dodge County, Minnesota, become
a Separate Election and Assessment District, Yes ___ No ___"; that the
