

IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF THE
HONORABLE WARREN F. PLUNKETT, JUDGE OF
THE DISTRICT COURT, THIRD JUDICIAL DISTRICT,
STATE OF MINNESOTA, FOR RETIREMENT PURSUANT

WHEREAS, the Honorable Warren F. Plunkett, Judge of the Third Judicial District, has submitted to the undersigned Governor of the State of Minnesota, a letter, dated November 30, 1981, applying for retirement from his position as District Judge, effective July 22, 1982, pursuant to the provisions of Minnesota Statutes Section 490.126, Subdivision 2; and


WHEREAS, said Warren F. Plunkett has served as a District Judge of said District Court continuously since 1955; and

WHEREAS, the said Warren F. Plunkett has satisfied the necessary legal requirements established under Minnesota Statutes Chapter 490 for such retirement at the close of business on July 22, 1982.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, Governor of the State of Minnesota, acting pursuant to the provisions of Minnesota Statutes Chapter 490, do hereby order and direct retirement of the Honorable Warren F. Plunkett, Judge of the District Court for the Third Judicial District, State of Minnesota, to become effective at the close of business on July 22, 1982. He shall thereafter become entitled to retirement compensation as provided under the provisions of Minnesota Statutes Chapter 490.


I hereby direct that this order be filed in the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.
