



Proclamation

WHEREAS: THE UNITED OSTOMY ASSOCIATION IS DEDICATED TO HELPING EVERY OSTOMY PATIENT RETURN TO NORMAL LIVING THROUGH MUTUAL AID, MORAL SUPPORT, AND EDUCATION; AND

WHEREAS: THE ADVANCEMENT OF KNOWLEDGE OF GASTROINTESTINAL DISEASE, COOPERATION WITH THE AMERICAN CANCER SOCIETY AND OTHER ORGANIZATIONS HAVING COMMON PURPOSES SHALL BE INCORPORATED TO ENHANCE THE REHABILITATION OF ALL OSTOMATES; AND

WHEREAS: THE MONTH OF AUGUST IS OSTOMY RECOGNITION MONTH, WHEN ELECTED MEMBERS ARE HONORED FOR OUTSTANDING SERVICE TO THEIR OSTOMY CHAPTERS AT THE ANNUAL UNITED OSTOMY ASSOCIATION CONFERENCE; AND

WHEREAS: IT IS DURING OSTOMY RECOGNITION MONTH THAT THE UNITED OSTOMY ASSOCIATION SPONSORS EDUCATION PROGRAMS WHICH INCLUDE PROMINENT CITIZENS FROM THE FIELD OF OSTOMY CARE AND REHABILITATED OSTOMATES, WHO WILL PARTICIPATE IN THE CONFERENCE IN ATLANTA, GEORGIA;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE MONTH OF AUGUST, 1982 TO BE
