



Proclamation

WHEREAS: OSTEOPATHIC MEDICINE IS ONE OF TWO COMPLETE SCHOOLS OF MEDICINE WHOSE PHYSICIANS PROVIDE THE FULL RANGE OF MEDICAL SERVICES; AND

WHEREAS: DOCTORS OF OSTEOPATHY, D.O.s, ALTHOUGH ONLY FIVE PERCENT OF THE COUNTRY'S PHYSICIAN MANPOWER, PROVIDE TOTAL HEALTH CARE TO MORE THAN TEN PERCENT OF THE PUBLIC, SOME 20 MILLION AMERICANS; AND

WHEREAS: THE PROFESSION, PREDOMINATELY COMPOSED OF FAMILY PHYSICIANS, IS HELPING TO MEET THE STATE OF MINNESOTA'S PHYSICIAN NEEDS; AND

WHEREAS: OSTEOPATHIC PHYSICIANS MADE A SIGNIFICANT CONTRIBUTION TO HEALTH CARE IN THE STATE; AND

WHEREAS: MINNESOTANS SHOULD BECOME MORE AWARE OF THE OSTEOPATHIC PROFESSION AND THE PART IT PLAYS WITHIN OUR HEALTH CARE SYSTEM;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF SEPTEMBER 12 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 18, 1982 TO BE

OSTEOPATHIC MEDICINE WEEK

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER, I URGE CITIZENS TO OBSERVE THIS WEEK WITH PROPER RECOGNITION.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS SECOND DAY OF AUGUST IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-TWO AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-FOURTH.
