WHEREAS: MIGRANT FARMWORKERS TRAVEL OVER 1,000 MILES EACH SUMMER TO WORK IN THE STATE OF MINNESOTA; AND

WHEREAS: MIGRANT FARMWORKERS HAVE CONTRIBUTED TO MINNESOTA'S AGRICULTURAL ECONOMY FOR OVER 50 YEARS; AND

WHEREAS: MIGRANT FARMWORKERS PERFORM ESSENTIAL WORK IN THE HARVEST OF ASPARAGUS, SUGAR BEETS AND OTHER CROPS IN THE STATE OF MINNESOTA; AND

WHEREAS: MIGRANT FARMWORKERS ENRICH THE CULTURAL EXCHANGES IN RURAL MINNESOTA AND PROMOTE UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN DISTINCT CULTURAL GROUPS;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM SATURDAY, JULY 24, 1982 TO BE

M I G R A N T F A R M W O R K E R D A Y

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS TWENTY-SECOND DAY OF JULY IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-TWO AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-FOURTH.
